Making a Gift Aid declaration on behalf of St Raphael's Hospice means that for every £ your goods raise, Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs will currently give us an additional 25p minimum, helping your donation go further. This means for instance that every £10 raised becomes a minimum of £12.50 – at no extra cost to you! Just think what a difference that can make.

By completing this form you are confirming that:

- You are a UK taxpayer (you must have paid an amount of income or capital gains tax equal to the tax that we can reclaim on your donations in the appropriate tax year – currently 25p minimum for each £ you give)
- You wish St Raphael's Hospice to act as your agent in selling the goods you have brought into the shop
- You wish St Raphael's Hospice to claim tax on all donations you have made 6 years prior to this date and from this date forward for all future donations
- You are not acting as a business in bringing goods in for sale to any of the shops belonging to St Raphael's Hospice

St Raphael's Hospice cares for over 900 local people each year.

We provide home visits from our nurses, a day centre, residential care and bereavement & family support. All services are provided free of charge to patients and families, but it costs over £3.6 million a year of which the NHS gives approx 28% but the remaining 72% of those costs come from donations, legacies and charitable fundraising, including the money raised by the St Raphael's Charity shops.
